Ferril Hagan, a 98 year old Trenton resident, passed away at 7:15 p.m. on Thursday, October 13, 2016 at the Convalescent Care Center in Excelsior Springs, MO where he had been under hospice care.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 16, 2016 at Resthaven Mortuary of Trenton. A scheduled family visitation will be held one hour prior to service time. Open viewing will be Saturday afternoon . Burial will be in Resthaven Memorial Gardens.

Mr. Hagan was born on September 1, 1918 in Mercer County, MO the son of James Stuart and Bessie Mable (Mark) Hagan. He attended the Center School at Saline, MO. He was married to Lois Annibel Kirkpatrick on August 12, 1939.

He was a member of the Bethel and Hatton Chapel Methodist Churches. He farmed in Mercer County until 1944 when he and Annibel moved to the Forks of the River, they lived on the family farm until 1975 before moving north of Trenton. As a member of MFA, Ferril made two trips with other area farmers to Washington DC to protest against dams on Grand River Basin and marketing.
