In September 1960 she remarried to Lloyd Lee "Tub" Barnes. They operated a gas and grocery store in Edinburg and then later Barnes Auto Wrecking. Tub also preceded her in death in 1998.

She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star #641 at Harlingen, TX.

She is survived by two step sons and eight nieces and nephews.

Those preceding her in death include her parents, husbands, a brother Carl, two sisters, Leota and Garnetta, a step brother Richard and a step son Jack Barnes.
