

William Allen Hamilton was born on July 25, 1928 in Council Bluffs, Iowa. He attended Catholic school and served as an altar server.

They married on November 19, 1949 at Holy Family Catholic Church in Council Bluffs, Iowa. Bill worked for the Milwaukee Rail Road as a telegraph operator and later as maintenance supervisor at the Iowa School for the Deaf.

In 1963, with seven children, Bill & Eleanor moved to Missouri and bought a farm in the Jamesport – Hickory area. There they had four more children.
