Mrs. Campbell was born July 9, 1922 on a farm near Galt, MO, the daughter of Clarence J. and Mary Dorinda Grim Davis. She was a 1940 graduate of the Galt High School. She was a member of the Trenton First Baptist Church and the Lydia Sunday School Class. She was also a member of the Rebekah Lodge #120 of Edinburg. On February 8, 1942 she married Forrest R. Jackson who died on February 7, 1979. She was preceded in death by both of her parents, and her brothers Claude, Fred and Leon Davis. The couple moved from a farm near Galt to Trenton in 1960. She worked at the Baker and P.N. Hirsch Stores prior to becoming a reporter for the Trenton Republican Times. After working there eight years, she accepted the position of Deputy County Clerk, retiring on March 19, 1987. She married Ivan Campbell on February 14, 1987, who preceded her in death in January of 2013.
