In 1952 Mrs. Clark graduated from North East State Teachers College at Kirksville with bachelor's degree in education, and then a Masters of Education in 1970. She retired from teaching in 1978. Mrs. Clark was an active member of the Calvary Baptist Church in Chillicothe where she taught Sunday school class for many years. She was also a member of many organizations including a life member of the Grand River Historical Society, the Genealogy Society of Grundy County, Delta Kappa Gamma Teachers Organization, the American Association of University Women and the Missouri Retired Teachers Association.

Mrs. Clark is survived by her niece Norma Fay Cross of Raymore, MO and a number of great nieces and nephews.

Those preceding her in death include her parents, husband, an infant son Gary J. Clark, two brothers Harry and Dale Brown, and a sister Fern Brown.
