In addition to his parents, Dr. Klinginsmith was preceded in death by four brothers, Samuel, Charles, Robert, and Raymond Klinginsmith, and three infant children, Samuel Wayne, Debra Kay, and Twila Jane.

Dr. George was born in Unionville, MO October 10, 1934, the son of Doctors Charles and Ruah (Channell) Klinginsmith.
