Ann Lee Obituary

Ann Marie (Haumschild) Lee, age 85 of Boscobel was granted her angel wings on September 28, 2015 after a short but courageous battle with lung cancer. Her final days were spent surrounded by family and friends who loved her.

Ann was born on February 27th, 1930 on a farm in the township of Aztalan WI. She was the first of 10 children born to Lawrence and Mary (Gericke) Haumschild. Ann will always be remembered for her fierce independence even to the end. She had a love for gardening and a passion for animals and wild life. You could find her watching birds out her kitchen window for hours. Also, her talent for sewing and canning will never be forgotten by those who were on the receiving end of those items.

Ann is survived by her 5 children and their spouses, Brother Lawrence (Bud) Haumschild of Boscobel WI, sister Mary Revolinski of Edgerton WI, brother Donald (Linda) of Fort Atkinson WI, sister Alice (Ed) Ley of Oconto Falls WI, brother Robert (Arlene) Haumschild of Johnson Creek WI, eight grandchildren, seven great grandchildren and Donna Nickels of Milton WI who considered Ann a second mother.
