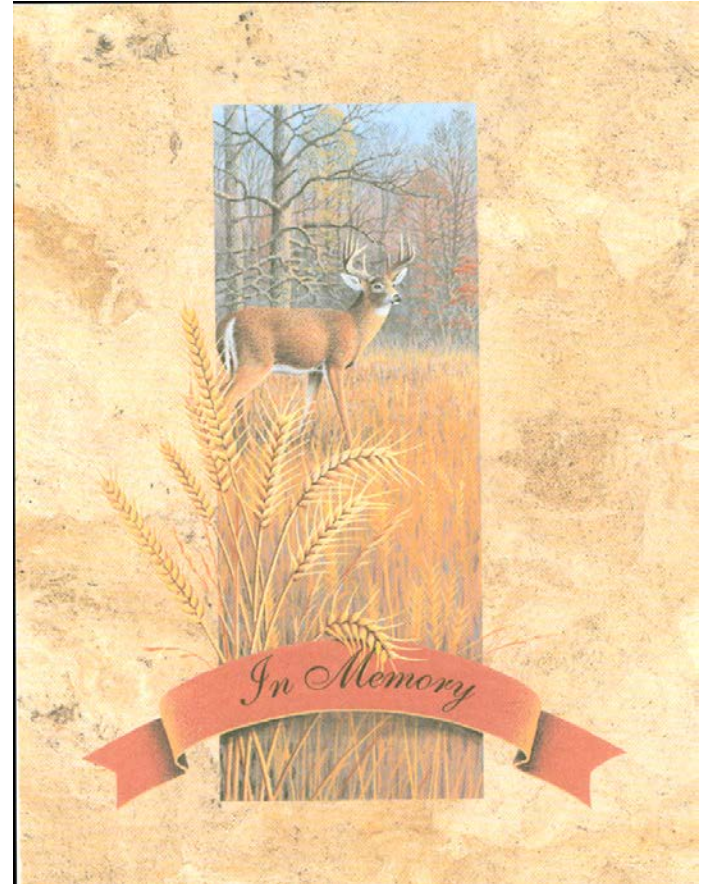


Fisherman's Prayer
